Notes: The Witwatersrand Agricultural Society was instituted 1894 and the fledgling 'Rand Show' was opened by Paul Kruger's following year. The shows ceased during the Boer War but recommenced in 1907 with show grounds in Milner Park. The the venue for the Rand Show until 1984. The Rand Show continues to be held annually during the Easter holidays. The has changed and the nature of the exhibition has become oriented towards family entertainment.

The style of this medal is similar to the pre-union medal (Laidlaw: 0144a) and to the union medal made at the Royal Pretoria (Laidlaw 144b) and at the South African Mint (Laidlaw: 0144c).
