Obverse: King Edward VIII, right, crowned and robed. Legend: "EDWARD . VIII . (left) KING & EMPEROR (right)".

Reverse: Within a laurel wreath tied at the botton, on a cartouche across: "ASCENDED THE THRONE (in an arc) / JANUARY 20 ABDICATED / DECEMBER 10 1936".

Notes: King Edward VIII (1894-1972) was the eldest son of King George V and Queen Mary. Edward became king when his fa in early 1936. He abdicated in December of that year in favour of marriage to the American divorcee Wallis Simpson. H younger brother then became King George VI.
