Obverse: Bareheaded robed bust of King, half left. Legend below: "KING EDWARD VII".

Reverse: On left, bareheaded uniformed bust of Duke, front, and on right, diademed bust of Duchess, front. Legend above: "DUKE & DUCHESS OF YORK" and below: "VISIT TO AMERICA".

Notes: The Duke and Duchess of Cornwall and York (later King George V and Queen Mary) visited Canada (but not the United States) during September and October 1901, travelling across the continent and back again. This was a component of a wider tour, including Australia, New Zealand and South Africa, partly as a show of Royal appreciation for loyalty during the Boer War.
