Top band: views of the Parliament Building in Cape Town (left) and the the Anglican Church on Robben Island (right). Bottom band: the entrance to MuseuMAfrica in Johannesburg. Legend above: "KRUGERRAND" and below: "SOUTH AFRICA"

Reverse: Map projection of the World. Legend above: "THE MOST POPULAR BULLION COINS" and below: "IN THE WORLD".
