Edge: Upright reeded: Pond, ½ Pond, 5 Shillings, 2 ½ Shillings, 2 Shillings, Shilling & 6 Pence.
Plain: 3 Pence, Penny, ½ Penny & ¼ Penny.

Obverse: Within a beaded border round the rim, bust of Paul Kruger, three quarters left. Signed: "GR" on truncation.

Reverse: Within a beaded border round the rim, Legend above in ornate letters: "Gold Reef City" and below denomination and date between stars, position varies. In the centre, image of an animal:

- (1) Pond: 22.0 mm. Giraffe
- (2) Half Pond: 19.2 mm. Kudu
- (3) 5 Shillings: 38.7 mm. Buffalo
- (4) 2 ½ Shillings: 32.2 mm. Lion
- (5) 2 Shillings: 28.3 mm. Elephant
- (6) 1 Shilling: 23.6 mm. Cheetah
- (7) 6 Pence: 19.2 mm. Springbok
- (8) 3 Pence: 16.1 mm. Hippopotamus
- (9) 1 Penny: 30.9 mm. Rhinoceros
- (10) ½ Penny: 25.4 mm. Leopard
- (11) ¼ Penny: 20.1 mm. Gemsbok

Notes: The proof-like set comes in the same blue case that was used by the SA Mint for the Union long proof set.

Gold Reef City Mint is a privately owned South African mint. Founded in 1986, it has been authorised by the SA Mint to mint certain South African coins under supervision. It is part of an entertainment park near Johannesburg with gold mining as a theme. These tokens were struck as a souvenir for visitors.
