Notes: The Royal Agricultural Society of Natal originated in the Pietermaritzburg Agricultural Society which was formed in 1851 the Boer War it became the Agricultural Society of Natal and in 1904 the Society was granted Royal status by King Edw The show grounds are 1.5 km north of the center of Pietermaritzburg. Apart from 1906, the year of the Natal Rebellion, Royal Show has been held annually. At present the Royal Show is held over 10 days from late May to early June with a 220 000 visitors.
