Reverse: Wreath of oak (left) and laurel (right) tied at the bottom with a ribbon enclosing space for engraving. Signed below: "W.V

STRAND.". This medal unengraved or engraving erased.

Notes: The suspension is missing from this medal. Correctly, an attached boss for a ring to a corded blue ribbon.

Nothing is known about this early Cape lifesaving society.
