Notes: The 2nd South African Rifles was an Imperial Regiment of South African and Rhodesian soldier who volunteered to figh German East African Campaign of the First World War. Officially the South African Defense Force could not be deployed than in the defense of the Union and so these troops had to be recruited and paid for by the British government. The re was divided into four squadrons of 110 men each.
