Reverse: Full Royal coat of arms with lion and unicorn supporters, crest and motto. Legend: "BORN MAY 24TH. 1819 . CROWNED JUNE 28TH. 1838 . MARRIED FEBRUARY 10TH. 1840". Across at bottom: "DIED JANUARY 22D. 1901".
