Obverse: Uniformed bust of Colonel Mackinnon wearing a slouch hat with C.I.V. badge, front and slightly left. In an arc below: "COLONEL W.H. MACKINNON". Legend: "IN MEMORY OF THEIR GALLANT DEEDS IN SOUTH AFRICA".

Reverse: Within a laurel (right) and oak (left) wreath tied at the bottom, across in large letters: "C.I.V." with ornaments above and below. In an arc above: "SOUTH AFRICA" and below: "1899 - 1900".

Notes: Colonel William Henry Mackinnon was the Colonel Commandant of the City Imperial Volunteers, established by Royal Warrant in 1880 and recruited from the greater London area.
