Form: Circular. Sometimes fitted with an ornate claw suspension bar and blue ribbon

Edge: Plain. Thickness 4.8 mm

Obverse: Within an ornate border round the rim, Veiled and diademed head of Queen Victoria, left. Signed: "A. FENWICK. F. BIR" on the truncation. Legend: "VICTORIA (left) REGINA (right)".

Reverse: Helmeted imperial soldier, shooting from the kneeling position on ground, left. Signed: "A. FENWICK. F" on the right on the truncation of the ground. Legend: "IN DEFENCE".

Notes: Believed to have been issued in Australia as a shooting medal during the Boer War.
